MORE THAN 15,000 FUTURE QUEENSLAND TERTIARY STUDENTS HAVE TODAY RECEIVED OFFERS FROM QTAC

More than 15,000 offers for 2024 have today gone out to Queensland’s future tertiary students, with Health again emerging as the most popular Field of Education.

QTAC today made 15,014 offers across 1326 different courses on behalf of 16 institutions.

Of these, 9066 offers went out to recent 2023 Year 12 graduates, with the remaining 5948 offers made to Non-Year 12 applicants.

Thousands of responses have already been received.

Health, by Broad Field of Education (FOE), once again topped the list, with 2634 adult applicants and 3290 recent Year 12 graduates receiving offers.

This FOE includes dental, nursing, mathematics, sports science, medical science, biomedical science and biotechnology, and laboratory science.

The most popular course was a Bachelor of Arts at The University of Queensland, which saw 330 offers made.

QTAC CEO Dr John Griffiths recognised the achievement of applicants in securing an offer for tertiary study in 2024.

“Whether this marks the culmination of their high school studies or the chance to take their life in a new direction as an adult, I congratulate them.”

Continuing on from last year's offer rounds, including December 2023, the total number of offers made to Queensland’s future tertiary students for study in 2024 sits at 43,350 as of today.
