GROWING NUMBER OF APPLICANTS SECURE THEIR FUTURE WITH TERTIARY OFFERS RELEASED TODAY

QTAC is delighted to announce that 13,778 offers have been made in today's tertiary study offer round, marking another milestone in Queensland's strong admissions year.

With more than 16,002 offers made in the December round alone, today's figures bring the admissions year-to-date total to more than 47,100 offers to study in 2025. This represents a remarkable 8.8% increase compared to the same period last year, reflecting growing demand for tertiary education in Queensland.

QTAC Interim CEO Chris Veraa highlighted the trends shaping this year's admissions cycle.

"The December offer round set a new benchmark, with record engagement from applicants across Queensland. The momentum continues today, as thousands more applicants take the next step towards their future."

In today's round, 13,778 offers were made across 1,333 courses from 17 of Queensland's leading institutions. Of these, 8,453 offers were made to recent Year 12 graduates, while 5,325 were issued to our adult applicants.

Health remains the most sought-after Field of Education, with 5,838 offers made today. Engineering and Arts also featured prominently amongst today's offer round, with strong interest in Bachelor of Arts, and Bachelor of Engineering (Honours).
